Dress Rehearsal Information

- Dress Rehearsals will be held at Saline High School.
- Dress Rehearsals may be running early. Please arrive 20 minutes before your child’s scheduled time, so we can keep the rehearsal running smoothly.
- Students must be in full-costume, hair, make-up, etc..
- **Only one adult is allowed to accompany their child to dress rehearsal.**

Ticket Information

We are only allowed a restricted number of people in the theater. 2 tickets per family have been factored in the count including staff, students and backstage crew. If we sell more than 2 tickets per family, we will be over capacity.

- Seats are reserved seating. Due to Covid restrictions each **family** is permitted only 2 tickets maximum.
* Dancers do not need a ticket if they are performing in the show and they remain backstage with the staff.
- If you plan to be backstage with your child to help change costumes, you will need to purchase one of the two allowed tickets for yourself. This is due to the number of people permitted in the building by the MDHH.
- Tickets may be purchased by reserving an appointment time. **May 1st** at 10:00am log-on to: www.centralcitydance.com on to book an appointment to purchase tickets **May 23rd**.
- **On May 23rd** you will arrive to Central City Dance Center during your families scheduled appointment time and select 1 or 2 tickets for your required recital performance. Cash or Credit Card only. Personal Checks will not be accepted during this time. When purchasing recital tickets May 23rd, be sure you are purchasing tickets for the correct show.
- Tickets are \$16
- If you wish to have your dancer sit with you in the theater, a ticket **must** be purchased (this would count as one of the two tickets your family is permitted).



A limited number of handicap seating is available. When choosing tickets online, select the handicap ticket option. Handicap tickets are \$16. and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

ShowTime Information



Arrival and Drop-off/Pick-up Info

- Students must arrive no later than 20 minutes before show-time dressed in their first costume with hair done and makeup applied.
- Students will remain backstage for the duration of the performance and may be picked-up following the performance unless a ticket was purchased for them to sit in the theater, or you wish to leave early.
- Parents wishing to go backstage to help change costumes must pick-up a backstage pass when dropping off their child. You must present your backstage pass to security when entering the backstage area for costume changes or when picking up your child following the performance.

Backstage

- There will be teachers backstage to supervise the students. **The teachers will NOT be responsible for changing your child into their costume.** If your child needs assistance changing into or out of their costume you must obtain a backstage pass when dropping them off in the holding room.
- A TV monitor will be provided for students to watch the show live while waiting to go on stage or waiting after they perform.
- **Costume Changes:** Students (**age 10 +**) may go directly to the dressing room following their group dance. If they have multiple costumes, you may meet them in the dressing room to assist with changing. Students (**age 9 and under**) need to be picked-up in the holding room after they perform to change their costume.
- Students **MUST** report into the holding room as soon as they are ready in costume. If they are not in the holding room they may not have time to make it to the stage. **(Parents: please remind your kids that they need to stay in the holding room. They cannot hang-out in the dressing rooms, the show will not stop for a missing student)**
- If your child plans to be in the holding room before & after they perform, please send your child with an activity book, puzzles or cards to keep them occupied during the performance.

Costumes

- Be sure you have the proper tights, and shoes (labeled with your name) to prevent confusion in the dressing rooms. We suggest each student have a garment bag (labeled with their name) to store and protect their costume. Downstage Dancewear sells garment bags.
- Many students bring a laundry basket labeled with their name to store their accessories, shoes, make-up cases and belongings.
- Students should wear a cover-up to protect their costume from make-up stains before and after the performance.
- Please do not wear jewelry or nail polish unless requested by your teacher.

Stage Make-Up & Hair

- Stage make-up is very important. It prevents the performer's face from washing out under the bright stage lights. Stage make-up is usually applied much heavier than normal day-to-day make-up. Please be sure to blend the make-up.
- Below is a list of preferred make-up colors that look great on-stage.



Eye Color- Soft brown eye shadow, eye liner and lots of mascara.

Cheek Color- Pink or rose color.

Lip Color- Pink or Red lipstick or lip gloss

- **Tips on making a bun:** Use a hair net around the bun. Hairspray and lots bobby pins. Hairnets can be purchased at Downstage Dancewear.

Photos & Video Recording

- Photography and/or Video Recording of any kind during the performance is strictly prohibited.
- A videographer will be video recording the Recital Performances.
- If you wish to purchase a DVD of your child's performance, please find the DVD pre-order forms located in the studio lobby.
- For the safety of the students and as a courtesy to the guests, persons found videotaping will be asked to leave. Thank you for your cooperation.
